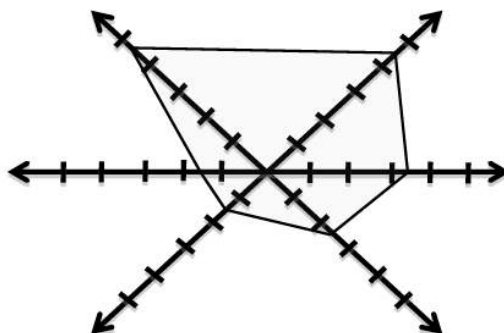
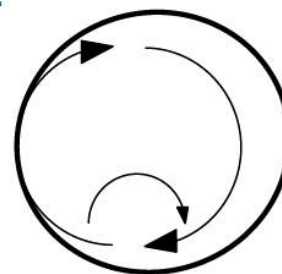
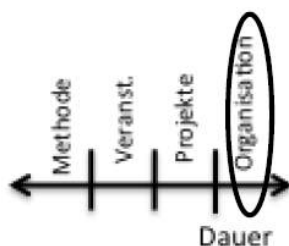


Organisationsverfahren: Lokale Demokratie Bilanz



Info: The „local democracy balance“ is an instrument to expand civic participation and citizen orientation. A citizen-survey and a baseline study in the administration form the core of the technique. According to the outcomes, concrete recommendations for actions are being worked out.

Origin / intention: The idea comes from scandinavia and wants local authorities to be more citizen-oriented.

Description: There are 10 steps:

- 1) Council order
- 2) Program group for process-facilitation
- 3) Investigation of the administration
- 4) Citizen-survey
- 5) Baseline study
- 6) Status report
- 7) Feedback-procedure
- 8) Status report into local council
- 9) Control of success
- 10) Repeat the local democratic balance
