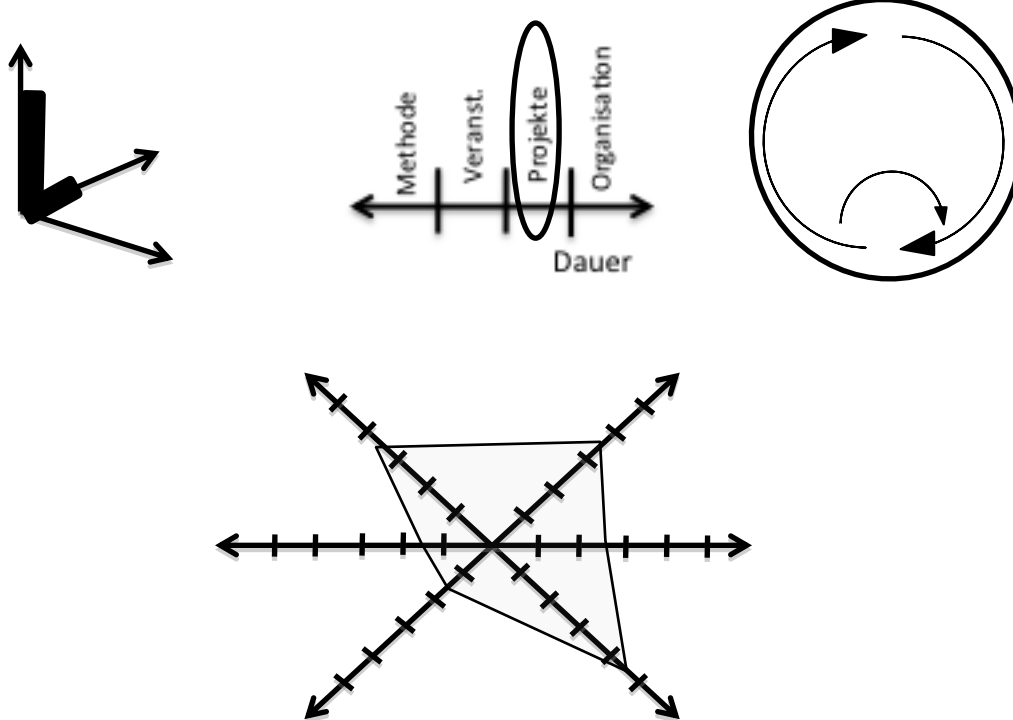


Methodenverfahren: Partizipative Evaluation



Info:

Participative evaluation is all about involving the stakeholders into the whole process. This means, they make the evaluation and define factors of success.

Origin / intention:

Participative evaluation was developed in 2001 by Susanne Ulrich and Florian Wenzel (CAP Munich).

Description:

At first, it must be clear, what is to be evaluated. Afterwards, the involved get invited. The organisers settle questions and expectations with the participants and develop a methodic design. When these steps are done, the data collection can be performed.

Characteristics: It is of high importance, that all processes are open and transparent for all participants.
